

Welcome to Friends of Long Island Centre (FOLIC). We hope your stay with us is enjoyable. To ensure a safe, respectful, and pleasant experience for everyone, FOLIC has established the following rules. Members are responsible for ensuring that all occupants and visitors comply with these rules.

REGISTRATION / VISITORS

1. All visitors must sign in through our website, **folic.ca**, under the **Membership** section, and purchase a valid **Day Pass, Weekly Pass, Carload Pass, or Seasonal Pass**.

Once payment has been received, you will receive an email with your **parking pass and visitor pass**. Please print the passes and display them on your dashboard as required.

If you experience any issues purchasing your pass online, you may purchase your pass directly from the **Camp Manager**.

2. If you encounter someone who appears to be unauthorized on FOLIC property, either address them respectfully or notify the FOLIC Manager.

VEHICLES

3. Vehicles may be on site for the purpose of dropping off, unloading, or loading materials. Please use the buggies provided for transporting materials and return all vehicles to the designated parking area immediately after use.

4. Vehicles must not be kept on **campsites, cabin area or cottage** for any reason.

5. Do not drive vehicles over FOLIC septic beds in the seasonal camping area.

6. The speed limit throughout the campground is **15 km/h**. Please respect this limit at all times, as we have children throughout the campground.

CAMPFIRES

7. Campfires are permitted only at the two designated locations and must be supervised by an adult at all times.

8. Fires must be fully extinguished after use and must never be left unattended.

9. Wood boxes are for firewood and clean newspaper only; do not place garbage in them.

When a Red Flag is posted, all campfires are prohibited due to City of Ottawa fire bans.
The campground provides all fire wood at no cost.

REFUSE / GARBAGE / RECYCLING

10. Dumping of sewage or grey water on the grounds is strictly prohibited; the designated dumping station must be used.
11. Garbage must be securely bagged and deposited in the bins provided.
12. Recycling must be sorted and placed in the appropriate recycling boxes.
13. Washing dishes in washroom sinks is not permitted; use Wood Hall kitchen sinks.

PETS

14. Pet owners must be able to physically control their pets at all times.
15. Pets must be leashed or securely contained within your site area while on FOLIC property.
16. Children who cannot control or clean up after a pet must not walk the pet alone.
17. Pet owners must immediately clean up after their pets and dispose of waste properly.
18. Pets may be off leash only within the designated Pet Exercise Area near the gated entrance.
19. Pets are not permitted in public buildings, washrooms, pool areas, fenced courts, or playground sand areas. Service dogs are exempt.
20. Pets must not disturb other campers; excessive barking may result in removal without refund.

SITES / TRAILERS / TENTS

21. Campsites must be kept neat, orderly, and free of clutter to prevent tripping hazards.
22. Each RV site may contain one recreational vehicle and one additional tent if space permits; no waterfront tents.
23. Clotheslines are not permitted; fold out clothes dryers may be used.
24. Cutting, removal, or damage to trees, plants, soil, rocks, wood, or wildlife is prohibited.
25. Trailer site dimensions are identified on the site map and must be respected.

CANNABIS

26. The cultivation or consumption of medical or recreational cannabis by inhalation is prohibited on FOLIC property.

GENERAL RULES

27. Quiet hours: Weekdays 11:00 pm–8:00 am; Weekends 12:00 am–8:00 am. Excessive noise is not permitted at any time.
28. The registered camper is responsible for the conduct of all children and guests.
29. Bicycles, rollerblades, and other wheeled vehicles are prohibited in fenced tennis courts. Playing hockey, baseball, basketball is also prohibited on the courts.
Please ensure you are playing tennis on the court that has the tennis court. Tennis balls are harder and can damage the pickleball nets.
30. All FOLIC equipment must be returned to designated storage areas after use.
31. Boats may be borrowed by signing out with the lifeguard; users must be 14+ or supervised; life jackets are mandatory.
32. Trailer air conditioners and unnecessary lights should be turned off when away for extended periods.
33. FOLIC Management is authorized to enforce these rules and may evict violators without refund.
34. FOLIC is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property, equipment, or vehicles.
35. Verbal or physical abuse of FOLIC staff, management, or executive members will result in immediate removal without refund.

CABIN/COTTAGE RENTALS

Check in time 2pm, check out time 11am

36. Cabin and cottage rentals may be subject to an additional **cleaning fee of \$75.00 if not adequately cleaned prior to checkout**. The cleaning fee will be deducted from your next visit, prior to approval of your booking. We provide the following cleaning supplies: Dustpan, Pail, Mop and cleaning supplies. Should you need additional supplies, please see **Camp Manager**.
37. Cabin = Please **do not shut off** the refrigerators when leaving.

HALL RENTAL

38. Please keep it clean and tidy. Do not **move the tables or chairs**, the FOLIC team will move them as needed.
